

TestNav Setup & Technology Readiness

For WY-TOPP & WY-ALT district technology readiness. Use this guide to prepare testing devices, verify the TestNav setup, and complete a district readiness check before students test.

Four-step readiness path

Step 1	Step 2
Prepare devices Identify testing devices. Review TestNav system requirements. Confirm network and filtering readiness.	Install TestNav Install TestNav for each operating system. Complete device-specific setup.
Step 3	Step 4
Run App Check Run App Check (Method 1, for ADAM) Confirm kiosk mode readiness. Confirm connectivity and blocked-app status. Resolve issues and rerun App Check.	Readiness Test Use planned rooms, devices, and network. Login to testing devices using secure practice tests from ADAM. Document issues, owner, and resolution.

Reminder for day-of-testing focus: Limit environment changes, close non-TestNav applications, capture exact error messages or codes, and validate assistive-technology or accommodation-dependent setups before operational testing.
